Prayer made in the instant petition is for quashing the FIR No.81 dated 15.05.2007, for offence under Sections 457 and 380 IPC, registered at Police Station Lalru, Distt. SAS Nagar (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom the basis of compromise deed dated 26.07.2015 (Annexure P-3) including the judgment of conviction dated 07.04.2014 (Annexure P-2) passed by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Dera Bassi.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the parties could not appear before learned Appellate Court to get their statements recorded in terms of the order dated 21.08.2015 passed by this Court. Therefore, he seeks another opportunity.

Previous orders show that this Court has already granted various opportunities to the parties to get their statements recorded before the appellate Court including vide order dated 21.08.2015, 23.09.2015 and

thereafter on 19.01.2016 to appear before the learned trial Court within one month from that day or any other date convenient to the Court so that statements of the parties can be recorded. Again, vide order dated 03.05.2016, another opportunity was granted to the petitioner, but still the parties have not appeared to make their statements.

Therefore, this Court finds that the petitioner is not interested to pursue the instant petition.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.
