This is a petition under Section 439 CrPC for the grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.109 dated 28.9.2015 under Sections 22/61/85 NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Amargarh, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the challan has been presented in this case and the petitioner is in custody since 28.9.2015.

Learned State counsel has accepted the custody period of the petitioner and submitted that the petitioner is not involved in any other case.

Keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner and also the fact that the challan has already been presented and without going into the merits of the

case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny her the concession of bail.

Accordingly, the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/ Duty Magistrate, Sangrur.

The petition stands disposed of.
