Instant petition has been preferred under Section 438 Cr.P.C. by Chamkaur Singh seeking pre-arrest bail in case FIR No. 454 dated December 04, 2015 under Section 420 IPC registered at Police Station East Sector 26, Chandigarh.

2. The contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. Petitioner is the victim of the fraud committed by travel agent and is not at all aware about the alleged documents attached with VISA application. Moreover, the documents are already in possession of the police and nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner. He further submits that he is not aware about the alleged firm, namely DJINN Life Style India Pvt. Ltd. Moreover, petitioner is ready to join the investigation and is abide by all the conditions imposed by this Court, in case, he is granted the concession

of pre-arrest bail.

3. This Court has given an anxious thought to the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner but does not find any legal or factual weight in view of the fact that there are specific allegations of cheating and fraud qua the petitioner. Even he used the forged and fabricated documents purported to be issued by the company-complainant. Even, he was not an employee of the said company but forged and fabricated balance sheets and other documents just to show that he worked with company-complainant.

4. In view of above, this Court is of the considered view that custodial interrogation of petitioner is essential to unearth all the ramifications involved in this case and in the absence of custodial interrogation of petitioner, investigation of this case is likely to be stultified.

5. Dismissed.
