This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.333 dated 06.12.2014 registered under Sections 22/61/85 of NDPS Act at Police Station Patti, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has now been in custody for about 10 months and even the trial has not been started.

Learned Deputy Advocate General on instructions from H.C. Gurpreet Singh states in case the petitioner does not obstruct the trial the prosecution will lead its entire evidence on or before 30.11.2016 and till such time the bail should not be granted to the petitioner.

I find this to be a fair submission. In the circumstances, in view of the undertaking given by the learned Deputy Advocate General, it is directed that in case the prosecution does not lead its entire evidence on or before 30.11.2016 (subject to the accused not obstructing the same) the petitioner be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
