JASPAL SINGH, J.(ORAL)

1. This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking quashing of FIR No.46 dated 02.08.2015, under Sections 323, 427, 447, 148, 149 and 506 of IPC registered at Police Station Hajipur, District Hoshiarpur, and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 27.03.2016 (Annexure P-2).

2. Vide order dated August 01, 2016, parties were directed to appear before the trial Court, for getting their statements recorded. In compliance thereof, report of the trial Court has been received, wherein, it has been categorically observed that the matter has been compromised between the parties and all the grievances have been settled amicably without any coercion or undue influence and also no other criminal case and proclamation proceedings is pending against either of the parties.

3. So, in view of circumstances narrated above as well as the observations made in cases reported as ***Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab & Anr. 2007(3) RCR (Criminal) 1052*** and ***Narinder Singh and Ors. vs. State of Punjab & Anr., (2014) 6 SCC 466***, I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for the benefit of the parties and would certainly bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and FIR No.46 dated 02.08.2015, under Sections 323, 427, 447, 148, 149 and 506 of IPC registered at Police Station Hajipur, District Hoshiarpur, and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are quashed qua the petitioners.
