By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioners have sought anticipatory bail in FIR No.107, dated 04.11.2015, registered under Sections 406 and 420 IPC, at Police Station City-I Malerkotla, District Sangrur.

The learned counsel for the petitioners states that they have been falsely implicated in the instant case. They have nothing to do with the present FIR. The other co-accused of the petitioners have already been enlarged on bail on the undertaking made by main accused, Jagjit Singh @ Ladi.

Heard.

The amount involved in the instant FIR is covered by the

undertaking of the Managing Director of the company whose bail petition has been dismissed. Since the undertaking made before this Court by main accused lacks *bona fide*, therefore, this Court is not inclined to grant the concession of anticipatory bail.

Dismissed.
