This petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for issuance of directions to respondent No.3 to conduct detailed/fair enquiry on the representation (Annexure P-7) against respondent Nos.5 to 14 for illegally trespassing upon the land of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar (Rural) to consider and decide the representation (Annexure P-7).

At the asking of the Court, Ms. Harsimrat Rai, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. A complete copy of the paper book has been furnished to the learned State counsel, in the Court.

In the circumstances, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar (Rural) is directed to decide the representation (Annexure P-7), moved by the petitioner, by passing a speaking order within a period of three weeks from the receipt of certified copy of the order.
