Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C praying for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.634 dated 18.11.15 under sections 3, 5, 8 C.S. Act registered at Police Station, Punhana, District Mewat.

Perusal of the F.I.R would reveal that upon secret information having been received, a police party conducted a raid in an abandoned building and whereupon fresh blood was found lying on the spot and one person was applying salt to the skins and who upon seeing the police party managed to escape. As per prosecution version the present petitioner was specifically named by the secret informer.

Perusal of the order dated 10.12.2015, passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Mewat declining anticipatory bail to the petitioner would reveal that there are five more cases registered against the present petitioner in different police stations of Mewat district relating to cow slaughter.

Counsel would place reliance upon documents placed on record at Annexure P-2, which has been issued by the Gram Panchayat of a village relating to Block Ferozepur Jirkha, District Mewat in terms of which the

present petitioner had participated in an auction for sale of dead animals and had been awarded the contract being the highest bidder at the rate of Rs.2800/-. Reliance upon such document is found to be misconceived inasmuch as the other five criminal proceedings that already stand initiated against the petitioner pertaining to the cow slaughter are at a point of time which is prior to the contract dated 1.4.2014 at Annexure P-2.

For the reasons recorded above, this Court is not inclined to extend the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Petition, accordingly, is dismissed.
