Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for issuance of directions to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondent No.7.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief claimed in the present petition, the petitioner has already made a representation dated 27.6.2016 (Annexure P-16) to the respondent No.2 i.e. Commissioner of Police, Amritsar. He further states that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to look into the contents of said representation.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Gurinderjit Singh, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.
