Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR No.326, under Section 306 IPC was registered at Police Station Division No.6, Ludhiana on 2.9.1989 and petitioner has earlier approached this court by way of Criminal Misc. No. M-18744 of 2015, which was dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to file fresh one in case the necessity so arises at the subsequent stage. He states that the withdrawal was prayed in view of the status report submitted by the respondents but now sufficient time has been elapsed. The investigation has not yet been completed. Accordingly, he has submitted the representation dated 31.10.2015 (Annexure P-7) addressed to respondent No.3 but no action thereof has been taken.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Sultan Singh Gill, Deputy A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to hand over requisite number of copies of paper book to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without commenting on the contents of the representation dated 31.10.2015 (Annexure P-7), the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, to look into the contents of the said representation and to act in accordance with law.
