The petitioners seek quashing of the FIR on the basis of compromise in a case of assault and trespassing.

It has been informed that five witnesses stand examined, but the complainant/respondent No. 2, namely Sadhu Ram, has not been examined. The next date of hearing before the trial Court is stated to be 07.12.2016.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction that the trial Court shall record the statements of the parties on the next date of hearing, regarding the matter having been

compromised and, thereafter opt to pass appropriate order in accordance with law. In the alternative, the order of acquittal can always be passed by the trial Court, after recording of the statements of the parties.
