Through the instant petition, the petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 69 dated 04.03.2013, registered under Sections 354, 323, 506, 148, 149 IPC read with Sections 3(1)(x), 3(i) and 4 of Scheduled Caste & Scheduled Tribes Act, Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to orders dated 25.01.2016, passed by this Court, the petitioners have appeared before the trial Court and have been admitted on interim bail.

Looking to all these circumstances, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 25.01.2016 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
