Pursuant to the compromise arrived at between the parties, a request is made to the Court for quashing of the FIR on the basis of compromise.

A direction was given by this Court to the parties to appear before the trial Court for recording of their statements. After recording of the statements of the parties, a communication has been sent to this Court that the matter has been compromised between the parties.

Following the judgment of this Court in the matter of

Kulvinder Singh and others v. State of Punjab and another, 2007 (3)

RCR (Criminal) 1052, I do not find any ground for declining the request for quashing of the FIR on the basis of amicable compromise arrived at between the parties.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and FIR No. 300 dated 12.09.2013, registered under Sections 34, 380 and 454 I.P.C. at Police Station Sector – 26, Chandigarh, and all the subsequent proceedings are hereby quashed.
