Custody certificates by way of affidavit of Kulwant Singh, Officiating Superintendent, Central Jail, Amritsar, have been filed. Same are taken on record.

This order shall dispose of Criminal Misc.No.M-26044 of 2016, filed by petitioner Gurwinder Singh alias Ravi and Criminal Misc.No.M-26058 of 2016, passed by petitioners Rohit Bhatti, Kawaljit Singh alias Lalla and Sharanjit Singh alias Sunny, under Section 439 Cr.P.C., seeking regular bail in case FIR No.417 dated 27.11.2015, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, District Amritsar City, under Sections 395, 327, 323, 324, 201, 398, 459, 427, 148, 149 IPC.

As per the allegations in the FIR, five persons entered the

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premises where the ATM was installed, injured the guard and tried to damage the ATM but were unsuccessful.

Learned counsel for the petitioners argued that the petitioners have been in custody for the last 07 months and 08 days and only simple injuries were caused to the guard and infact no robbery could be effected.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, has accepted the factual assertions.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and the facts that the petitioners are in custody for the last 07 months and 08 days; only simple injuries were caused to the gaurd; no robbery could be effected and without commenting on the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioners on regular bail to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Ordered accordingly. Both the petitions stand allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
