By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in a case FIR No.23, dated 17.02.2016, registered under Sections 120-B, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 465 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Dayalpura, District Bathinda.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the order dated 15.09.2016 has been complied with.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the

merits of the case, the ad-interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 15.09.2016, is made absolute, subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
