By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No.76, dated 06.07.2016, registered under Section 420 IPC, at Police Station Bhikhi, District Mansa.

The learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is agent of the crown company and he used to deposit the amount in the accounts of the company. No amount has been usurped by the petitioner.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel states that

the petitioner in connivance with main accused has usurped the huge amount.

Heard.

The amount involved in the instant FIR is covered by the undertaking of the Managing Director of the company whose bail petition has been dismissed. Since the undertaking made before this Court by main accused lacks *bona fide*, therefore, this Court is not inclined to grant the concession of bail.

Dismissed.
