Prayer made in the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.67, dated 08.06.2016, for offence punishable under Sections 307/452/323/506/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Passiana, District-Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is in custody since 09.06.2016. The injury caused to the injured was on the non-vital part of the body and the parties have entered into a compromise. He further submits that petition bearing CRM-M-No.24048 of 2016 titled as **“Gurpreet Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another”** seeking quashing of the FIR on basis of compromise has also been filed by the parties and the same is pending consideration before this Court for 29.08.2016.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Head Constable-Nazar Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact.

Heard.

Keeping in view of the fact that the trial in the case is at initial stage, coupled with the fact that the matter has been compromised between the parties, no useful purpose would be served to keep the petitioner in custody.

Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.

However, observation made here-in-above shall not be construed as an expression on the merits of the case and the trial Court shall be at liberty to decide the case on the basis of available evidence.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
