This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.117 dated 02.07.2016, registered under Sections 420, 120-B IPC, at Police Station “E” Division, Amritsar, District Amritsar.

On 08.08.2016, the following order was passed:-

“Learned Addl. A.G. states that it is the case of counsel for the petitioner that whatever offence was committed, was committed by Jaspal Singh. She further states that it is incumbent upon the petitioner to inform the address of Jaspal Singh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that petitioner will try to ascertain the same and inform it to the Investigating Officer.

In the circumstances, let the petitioner appear before the Investigating Officer on 19.08.2016 or on any other date on

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*which her appearance is required by the Investigating Officer.
On her appearance the I.O. shall release her on interim bail to
his satisfaction subject to the conditions as envisaged under
Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.*

Adjourned to 26.09.2016 .”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Satnam Singh,
has stated that the petitioner-co accused has cooperated with the prosecution
and pursuant to that cooperation, the main accused Jaspal Singh has been
arrested.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case,
I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to
the petitioner in the present case.

Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 08.08.2016, passed by this
Court, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section
438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal
miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
