FATEH DEEP SINGH, J (ORAL)

Allegations against the petitioner Pargat Singh in this regular bail application under Section 439 Cr.P.C. are that he along with co accused non-applicant Shehbaz Singh on 08.03.2016 have by using khakhi turban impersonated as police officials with false identity proof. It is argued on behalf of the petitioner by his counsel that co-accused Shehbaz Singh has been allowed this relief vide orders dated 11.05.2016 and the case of the petitioner is not distinguishable from that of his co-accused which is duly conceded to by learned State counsel.

Keeping in view the contentions and the fact that the trial will take a long time to conclude, this Court is of the opinion that further detention of the petitioner in the present case is not warranted. Accordingly, he is ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate, Ludhiana.

The present petition stands disposed off accordingly.
