On asking of Court, Mr. Munish Sharma, Asstt. Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the said respondents. A copy of the paper book be handed over to him.

Mr. M.D. Khan, Advocate has put in appearance on his own on behalf of private respondents and though has tried to oppose the relationship of the petitioners but this Court is only granting protection which is a fundamental right under Article 21 of the Constitution of India.

The petition stands disposed off with direction to the official respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation of the petitioners (Annexure P-4) and to ensure due protection of life and personal liberty of the petitioners at the hands of the private respondents No.4 to 7 within the framework of law.

Meanwhile, in case any instance of threat is brought to the notice of the Police by the petitioners they will take appropriate legal action expeditiously in accordance with law.
