INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioners, Kamaldeep alias Kala, Vikas alias Mangu and Jagtar Singh have preferred the instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.148 dated 07.06.2016, registered at Police Station Ladwa, District Kurukshetra, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 325, 452, 506 IPC.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and the complainant also appeared through his counsel. They contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner; learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for the complainant and have gone through the record.

The petitioners are stated to be in custody since 08.06.2016. They are not required for investigation or interrogation purposes as they are in judicial custody. The offences are triable by the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioners in custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition stands accepted and the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail subject to their furnishing bail bonds in the sum of ₹40,000/- with one surety in the like amount each to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
