The petitioner seeks quashing of the FIR on the basis of compromise in a case registered at the instance of respondent No. 2/complainant, namely Gurdev Singh, to the effect that he has been duped by the petitioner with a false promise to send his son abroad.

Despite service, no one has put in appearance on behalf of the private respondent.

In view of the above, the petition is disposed of with a direction that in case, the complainant does not want to pursue against the petitioner, he would voluntarily offer his statement to the

investigating officer within a period of two months. It will be open to the investigating officer, on the basis of the said statement, to file cancellation/untraced report, which may be accepted by the Court concerned in accordance with law.
