Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.97 dated 8.7.2016, under Sections 323, 341, 342, 379, 506, 427, 148, 149 and 308 IPC, registered at Police Station Phagwara, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that he does not press this petition qua petitioner No.1-Meeka at this stage.

Accordingly, the present petition qua petitioner No.1-Meeka is dismissed as not pressed.

Learned counsel further submits that pursuant to order dated 1.8.2016, petitioner No.2-Shinda has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by ASI Sarabjit Singh,

has stated that in terms of the above order the petitioner No.2-Shinda has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, the present petition qua petitioner No.2-Shinda is allowed and interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 1.8.2016 are made absolute.

However, petitioner No.2-Shinda shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
