The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.90 dated 20.05.2016, registered under Sections 323, 341, 308 and 148 read with Section 149 of the Indian Penal Code, at P.S. Division No.8, Jalandhar.

Contents that it is a case of version and cross-version. The altercation took place on playing of loud music at night time. The petitioner and his family members also received multiple injuries and FIR No.91 under Sections 323, 341 and 148 read with Sections 149 IPC stands registered against the complainant and his family members. Further states that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioner has repeatedly joined the investigation.

On the other hand, learned State counsel, on instructions, states that though the petitioner has joined the investigation, but injury No.2 on the head of the injured Mukesh Kumar, which has been declared as dangerous to life, has been attributed to the petitioner.

Heard.

The petitioner has been attributed injury on the vital part i.e. head of the injured, which has been declared as dangerous to life. Keeping in view the seriousness of the allegations, no case for grant of bail is made out at this stage.

Dismissed.
