Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for directing the respondent No.2 to file cancellation report in FIR No.214 dated 27.11.2008, under Sections 324 and 323 read with Section 34 IPC (later on Section 302 IPC was added), registered at Police Station Amloh, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioners confines his argument for expediting the investigation. He states that though the FIR has been registered on 27.11.2008 but the investigation has not been completed so far. He states that the speedy trial is one of the fundamental rights of an accused. He further states that in order to expedite the investigation, the petitioner has already approached to the respondent by way of representation dated 5.1.2016 (Annexure P-1).

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Sultan Singh Gill, Deputy A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. Learned counsel for the petitioners is directed to hand over requisite number of copies of paper book to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without going into the contents of the representation dated 5.1.2016 (Annexure P-1), the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Fatehgarh Sahib to look into the contents of the said representation and to act in accordance with law.
