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**M.M.S. BEDI, J. (ORAL)**

Petitioner has lodged an FIR annexure P-1 alleging that he has entered into an agreement of sale on payment of sum of Rs.1.50 lacs on behalf of Pawan Kumar and that he has been defrauded.

Through instant petition, the petitioner seeks a direction for appointment of an independent agency like CBI to look into the circumstances and take action against respondents 5 to 9, the property dealers who are allegedly selling agriculture land and unauthorized colonies without CLUs.

A perusal of the record indicates that the petitioner and Rohtash are in legal battle against each other as is apparent from the legal notice sent

by Rohtash, annexure P-2 and the reply filed on behalf of the petitioner through counsel. A representation, annexure P-5, in this regard has also been submitted by the petitioner to SP.

Taking into consideration the circumstances, I do not find it a case where the investigation could be referred to CBI. It will always be open to the petitioner to approach the senior police officers along with the material to satisfy the police authorities that cognizable offence warranting any action is made out.

Counsel for the petitioner has made an attempt to refer to some documents which are not part of the record.

It will be open to the petitioner to approach the senior police officers along with those documents and seek action in accordance with law but prima facie I do not find any allegations warranting interference at this stage.

Disposed of as premature at this stage.
