Counsel having argued the matter at some length prays for withdrawal of the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in cross-case in FIR No.337 dated 15.11.2015, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 325, 326, 307 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Pundri, District Kaithal.

Counsel further undertakes that the petitioner is otherwise ready and willing to surrender and prays for indulgence that if thereafter an application is filed seeking benefit of bail, the same be directed to be decided forthwith.

As per submission made by counsel, petition is dismissed

as withdrawn.

It is, however, observed that in case the petitioner duly surrenders before the Investigating Officer/Illaq Magistrate within a period of one week from today and thereafter files an application for bail, the same would be considered strictly on merits and the Court below would make every endeavour to expedite the disposal of the same.
