This is a petition for anticipatory bail filed in case bearing FIR No. 133 dated 14.09.2015, under Section 18 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Passiana, District Patiala.

Learned counsel has argued that the alleged recovery is of 1 Kilogram opium and that too from the co-accused who was allegedly arrested from the spot and it was only on the basis of the statement of the co-accused that the petitioner is sought to be implicated. Learned Addl.AG, on instructions from HC Paramjeet Singh, has accepted these factual assertions.

Keeping in view the fact that the recovery is of non-commercial quantity and the petitioner was not arrested from the spot and no other case is pending against him, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Let him appear before the investigating

officer on 26.08.2016 or on any other date on which his presence is required by him. On his appearance the investigating officer shall release him on bail to his satisfaction subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) CR.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the Civil Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
