This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.99 dated 05.06.2016, registered under Sections 420/120-B IPC, 406/467/468/477 A IPC (added later on), at Police Station E-Division, Kotwali, Amritsar.

After arguing for some time, the learned counsel for the petitioners states that he does not wish to press this petition on merits but liberty may be granted to the petitioners to surrender before the trial Court and move an application for regular bail and a direction may be issued to the Court to decide the said application expeditiously.

I find this to be a fair request. Let the petitioners surrender before the Court on 03.10.2016 and move an application for regular bail which shall be decided expeditiously by the Court but in any case on or before 06.10.2016.

Petition stands dismissed as having been not pressed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
