Grievance of the petitioner is that he is being summoned by the police at Ludhiana. Though all transactions between the parties took place at Anandpur Sahib. State has filed reply by way of affidavit of Pirthopal Singh, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Investigation, Ludhiana has been filed in court. Same is taken on record. According to her, Ludhiana Police does not take any action in the matter. Even otherwise, jurisdiction would lie with the appropriate police station.

In view of affidavit filed by the State, no cause of action survives in this petition. Same is rendered infructuous. Disposed of as such.
