Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.357 dated 24.05.2016 under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Camp Palwal, District Palwal.

This Court vide order dated 02.08.2016, while issuing notice of motion, has granted ad-interim bail to the petitioner subject to joining the investigation as and when directed by the Investigating Agency/Investigating Officer and to abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

However, when the case was listed before this Court on 18.10.2016, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Mahesh Kumar, had pointed out that under the garb of interim order, petitioner is not cooperating in the investigation. Accordingly, he was again directed to appear before the I.O. on 19.10.2016 at 11.00 AM to join and to cooperate

in the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to orders dated 02.08.2016 and 18.10.2016, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by ASI Mahesh Kumar, has stated that in terms of above orders, petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and interim directions issued by this Court vide orders dated 02.08.2016 and 18.10.2016 are made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
