Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for issuance of a direction to the respondents for initiating appropriate action on the representations made by the petitioner.

Learned senior counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner does not press his prayer so far as registration of the case is concerned. He, however, states that for the illegality committed by the accused, the petitioner has submitted various representations including the representation dated 8.7.2014 (Annexure P-5), but no action thereon has been taken.
