Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos.4 to 6.

Mr. Rishi Tandan, Advocate has entered appearance on behalf of respondents No.4 and 5-parents and prays that they may be allowed to meet their daughter-petitioner No.1. Allowed as prayed for.

After spending few minutes in my Chamber by the respondents No.4 and 5-parents and their daughter-petitioner No.1, the petitioner No.1 still insisted upon to go with her husband-petitioner No.2. On that learned counsel of the respondents No.4 and 5 has pointed out that the petitioner No.1 is the only child of her parents and the petitioner No.2 lives in the immediate proximity of the house of the parents of the petitioner No.1. On this the petitioners have stated that they would remove themselves from Patiala and will live somewhere else in some other town.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. They are stated to be major. In support of her proof of age petitioner No.1 has placed on record a copy of Secondary Examination Certificate (Annexure P-1) wherein her date of birth is mentioned as 12.11.1990 whereas petitioner No.2 has placed on record a copy of Voter Identity Card (Annexure P-2) depicting his date of birth as 11.10.1988. They have also moved a representation before the Sr. Superintendent of Police, Patiala (Annexure P-5) for protection of their life and liberty.

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-the Sr. Superintendent of Police, Patiala to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-5).

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
