This is a petition for challenging the order dated 09.04.2013 of the trial Court ordering further investigation.

After arguing for some time learned counsel for the petitioners states that without going into the merits at this stage he would not press this petition in respect of petitioners No.1, 2 and 3 and would contest that case provided the complainant side is willing to give up petitioners No.4 and 5 from the array of accused because both of them were unmarried at the time of the occurrence and have now settled down in their respective lives.

Learned counsel for the respondents No.2 and 3 has accepted this.

In the circumstances, the petition qua petitioners No.4 and 5 is allowed and that qua petitioners No.1, 2 and 3 is dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
