FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in FIR No.144 dated 14.09.2015 under Sections 323,325,308,148 and 149 IPC registered at Police Station Division No.7, Jalandhar.

The allegations against the petitioner-Mukesh Kumar @ Keshu in this regular bail application are that on 07.09.2015 the accused along with his co-accused/non-applicant has caused injuries to Sunny Suri.

It is inter alia argued by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has been attributed only a simple injury by means of baseball bat and that he is in custody since 25.10.2015.

In view thereof and keeping in view the inordinate delay in lodging the FIR and that the trial is not likely to

be concluded in near future and no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars, without adverting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition for grant of regular bail is allowed. Petitioner be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
