JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

Prayer is for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. to the petitioner in case FIR No.101 dated 29.08.2015, under Sections 365, 506, 323, 364, 470, 120-B, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Bullowal, District Hoshiarpur.

The allegations are that Sukhwinder Singh @ Kala i.e. son of the complainant was picked up at night from his house and thereafter given 20 injuries on his person and was left in the fields at night.

It is contended that all the injuries have been opined to be simple in nature except one, which is grievous. It is next contended that co-accused/non-applicants, namely, Sunny and Sukhjit @ Sabi have since been granted regular bail by this Court, vide order dated 05.01.2016.

The petitioner is stated to be in custody since 01.09.2015 and the challan has been presented.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Sukhvinder Singh, does not refute the fact regarding custody period, challan presented and co-accused have been granted bail.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the parity of treatment, custody period and the facts as noticed above, this Court finds that petitioner/accused deserves the concession of regular bail and as such he is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate, Hoshiarpur.
