Learned counsel for the petitioner has *inter alia* argued that on account of an evasive approach adopted by the complainant and other prosecution witnesses, delay is being caused in order to harass the petitioner who is in custody with effect from 22.03.2016 as only one witness has been examined.

Taking into consideration the peculiar facts of this case, without expression of any opinion on merits, the petition is disposed of with a direction that the trial Court shall conclude the trial by examining all the prosecution witnesses within a period of four months after the next date of hearing.

In case, the direction of this Court is not complied with, it will be open to the petitioner to approach this Court again for grant of bail.
