Petitioner-Sanjay alias Chela has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.24 dated 14.01.2014, registered at Police Station Narnaund, District Hisar, under Sections 323, 307, 447, 302, 34, 147 and 148 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued in this case.

Mr. Vikas Chopra, DAG, Haryana, has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition. Police record has also been produced.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned State counsel and gone through the record.

As per the prosecution version, on 13.04.2014, the present petitioner along with co-accused in furtherance of the common intention caused injuries to Ram Mehar and Ved Parkash. Ram Mehar died due to the injuries. The present petitioner also caused injuries to Ram Mehar.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence and in view of the fact that only eight witnesses have been examined so far and if the petitioner is released on bail, he may tamper with the evidence also, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled for benefit of regular bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.

However, as the petitioner is in custody since 14.01.2014, therefore, trial Court is directed to expedite the trial by giving short adjournments or by adjourning the case on day to day basis, if necessity arises, and conclude it preferably within six months. Investigating Officer/Station House Officer of the concerned police station is also directed to produce all the remaining prosecution witnesses for examination before the learned trial Court on the next date and also on the next two-three dates.
