B of the IPC, at Police Station Division No.6, Industrial Area, Ludhiana.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner has
been in custody since 14.6.2016 and it is a case of Magisterial trial.

Counsel for the complainant, as well as learned DAG Punjab

have accepted these factual assertions.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.
