CRM No.24744 of 2016

By virtue of the instant application preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C., applicant No.1 has sought permission to withdraw the petition bearing *CRM-M No.25452 of 2015* captioned as *Lalit Bhardwaj and others vs. State of Haryana and another*, however, applicant No.1 has also sought liberty to file a fresh petition on the same cause of action with better particulars.

Since applicant No.1 does not want to proceed with the instant petition on account of the fact that it lacks some better particulars, applicant No.1 is permitted to withdraw the aforesaid petition with liberty to file fresh on same cause of action with better particulars.

In view of order passed in *CRM No.24744 of 2016*, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn qua petitioner No.1 with liberty

to file fresh on same cause of action with better particulars.

As far as the applicants No.2 to 7 are concerned, Mr. A.S. Cheema, Advocate had earlier appeared and no objection for his appearance on behalf of petitioners No.2 to 7 was given but today neither petitioners No.2 to 7 nor their counsel Mr. A.S. Cheema has come present, meaning thereby, there was none to pursue the matter on behalf of applicants No.2 to 7. Thus, this Court is left with no option but to dismiss the petition qua petitioners No.2 to 7 for want of prosecution and the order is made accordingly.
