Learned counsel for respondent No.4 has submitted that interim order has been obtained by mentioning the wrong facts and date of birth of petitioner No.1. However, it has been submitted that there is no intention of the private respondents to cause any harm to the life and liberty of the petitioners.

In view of said circumstances, this petition is disposed of without expression of any opinion regarding the status of the parties as married couple. However, taking into consideration the constitutional right of the petitioners, it is ordered that petitioners will not be forcibly taken in custody by any of the respondents on the allegation that petitioner No.1 has been kidnapped or abducted by petitioner No.2, unless until any such statement is made by petitioner No.1.
