Allegations against the petitioner Krishan in this anticipatory bail application under Section 438 Cr.P.C. are that while standing in the area of Police Station Sadar Karnal he along with others had accosted six cows and one bull being ferried in a vehicle bearing registration No.HR69B-0283 and in the ensuing scuffle it is alleged that mobile handset of the complainant was snatched by the petitioner.

Contentions of learned counsel for the petitioner are that only simple injuries have been attributed to the petitioner and joining of investigations will suffice the purpose.

Though, the bail application has been stoutly opposed by the learned State counsel however, having regard to the totality of

allegations and that it is a debatable issue as to which of the parties was the aggressor, it would be a travesty of justice to send the petitioner in custody and mere joining of investigation will suffice the purpose.

In view thereof, in the event of arrest, petitioner is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). He shall continue to join investigation and shall furnish an undertaking that he shall abide by the conditions specified under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
