JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Prayer in this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, is for grant of regular bail on behalf of the accused/petitioner-Gurmukh Singh in case FIR No. 12, dated 12.03.2015, for offences punishable under Sections 307, 341, 382, 427, 323, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Sherpur, District Sangrur.

On 11.03.2015, complainant-Balraj Kumar and his son (Akashdeep) were going to Sherpur after withdrawing a sum of Rs. 2 lacs from bank in their car when they were intercepted by the accused party in a car comprising of the present accused Gurmukh Singh, Kamalpreet, Singh, Gurwinder Singh alias Sunny and Lalli. Kamalpreet Singh and Gurwinder Singh are alleged to have broken the window pane of the front left door and the window pane of the rear left door of the car, respectively. Akashdeep (son of the complainant), however,

escaped with bag containing cash. Accused/petitioner-Gurmukh Singh is alleged to have given a *punch* on the face of complainant and also snatched Rs. 5,000/- from his pocket.

The petitioner is stated to be in custody since 15.03.2015.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Malkiat Singh, submits that the complainant-Balraj Kumar as also his son (Akashdeep) still remain to be examined.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
