The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.414, dated 14.12.2015, registered under Sections 399, 402 of the IPC, and Section 25 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Civil Lines, Sonapat.

As per the allegations, the petitioner was preparing for dacoity.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner has been in custody since 14.12.2015; only one witness has been examined, and that two other co-accused have been granted the concession of bail.

Custody certificate has been filed by way of letter issued by the Superintendent, Central Jail No.4, Tihar, New Delhi to the Advocate General Haryana which confirms the above fact.

Learned DAG Haryana, on instructions from ASI Jagdish, accepts the factual assertions.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition stands disposed of.
