Learned counsel for the petitioners at the very outset states that in document annexure P-2 there is a typographical mistake because instead of 'Mehak Wadhwa' it has been mentioned as 'Shiv Dayal'. He is permitted to make necessary correction in the paper book.

Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos.5 and 6.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. They are stated to be major. In support of his proof of age

petitioner No.1 has placed on record a copy of Middle Standard Examination Certificate (Annexure P-1) wherein his date of birth is mentioned as 08.10.1992 and petitioner No.2 has placed on record a copy of Matriculation Examination Certificate (Annexure P-2) wherein her date of birth is mentioned as 08.12.1991. They have also moved a representation before the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar (Annexure P-6) for protection of their life and liberty.

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-6).

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
