Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos.4 to 6.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. As per the documents placed on record, the petitioner No.1 is 17 years and 5 months old girl and the petitioner No.2 is 18 years old boy.

They have also moved a representation before the Sr. Superintendent of Police, Bathinda (Annexure P-4) for protection of their life and liberty.

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy and commenting on the validity of the marriage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-the Sr. Superintendent of Police, Bathinda to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-4).

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
