The present petition had been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C praying for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.96 dated 15.3.2005 under sections 406, 420, 506, 34 I.P.C, registered at Police Station, Sadar Jhajjar, District Jhajjar.

Order sheet would reveal that this case had come up for hearing before this Court on 29.8.2013, 9.9.2013, 10.10.2013 and 29.11.2013 and on each of these dates counsel had sought time to complete instructions and to argue the case. On account of repeated adjournments having been sought, matter was adjourned sine die.

Registry has now put up the case for hearing and is listed for today.

Counsel appearing for the petitioner again states that his instructions are not complete.

The only inference that can be drawn by this Court is that the petitioner is not inclined to pursue the present petition which was filed in the month of August, 2013 for grant of concession of pre-arrest bail.
