This office has listed this case for completion of service of respondents. On perusal of the file this Court is of the view that the main case itself be disposed of because in the connected case i.e. CWP No.1555 of 2002 titled *Kulwant Singh v. State of Punjab and others* the Division Bench of this Court was informed by the learned State counsel that Government had taken a decision not to make any appointment in pursuance to any recommendation made by the Commission. The State had produced letter dated March 21, 2002 to this effect. Consequently, that petition was rendered infructuous and was disposed of by order dated May 15, 2002. This means that respondent No.2 though selected has not been offered appointment as a result of the decision discarding the selection process.

The claim in this petition is for the post of Lecturer in Punjabi in a selection process which has become infructuous.

Consequently, this petition is also disposed of.
