The petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in FIR No.159 dated 26.05.2015 registered under Sections 15, 25, 61, 85 Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act at Police Station Dakha, District Ludhiana Rural

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties and perused the impugned order and reasons therein.

In view of the fact that recovery effected falls within the ambit of commercial quantity, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, present petition stands dismissed.
