The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 465 dated 09.12.2014, registered under Sections 323, 324, 341 and 148 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'the IPC') read with Section 149 IPC and Sections 325 and 326 IPC (added later on), at Police Station Civil Lines Amritsar City, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has joined the investigation in pursuance of the order dated 04.08.2016 passed by this Court. He further states that injuries attributed to the petitioner are on the non-vital part. It is a case of version and cross-version.

On the other hand, learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 04.08.2016, is made absolute, subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
